GIFT AID

Increase the value of your payments to the Association at no cost to yourself.

Gift Aid is a scheme that allows charities and eligible clubs to claim from HMRC the basic rate of tax that their donors have paid. Gift Aid increases the value of subscriptions and donations by 25% without costing you any extra. The N&DOA can claim Gift Aid if you have paid UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax during the tax year. The amount of tax paid must be at least equal to the value of Gift Aid that the N&DOA will claim on your subscription or donation.
